The Church View surgery in Rayleigh previously utilised an assortment of open wooden shelves, which didn't stimulate clean, safe contents or easy access to the 8000 patient records. Enter the Railex Rollastore, which is a pre-set concept of light grey storage bays running along tracks laid into a plinth on the floor. The bays open or close as desired at the light turn of ergonomic hand wheels, and the whole unit can be locked as required. The strong, rigid steel construction offers stability and intrinsic safety features, whilst also offering simple identification and retrieval of the "Lloyd George" wallets in their standard trays.
